Using a case study approach (Baxter & Jack, 2008; Yin, 2014), researchers gathered data from school counselors (= 18), district-level coordinator (= 1), facilitators who provided the RAMP training in their region (= 4) and representatives from the state DOE (= 2). Researchers received a grant from ASCA to conduct this case study, gleaning a multi-level perspective of the RAMP cohort process.
